With these new Governmental restrictions in place, we are unable to hold worship services in our small building and so must resort to Facebook Live on Sunday mornings. While we are able to continue our weekly prayer meetings on Tuesday evenings, we had to move the meeting time up by thirty minutes to be able to get everyone home by the new 8:00 pm curfew. All other activities and clubs are more or less at a standstill during the current restrictive atmosphere.

The questions every missionary faces right now: How do I minister when contacts and activities are so limited? How do I continue to reach people with the Gospel? In light of all we *can't* do, what *can* we do? As we wrestle with these questions, we continue to bring them to God, asking Him to show us the way. So many broken, scared, depressed and desperate souls are in need of the hope of the Gospel.

We know that God:

- desires all people to be saved and come to the knowledge of truth (I Tim 2:4)
- has shone (and will shine) in hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God (II Cor 4:6)
- is not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance (II Pet 3:9)
